

How to Register

Registration

All “Walk to Remember” participants must read, complete and sign the registration form. A parent and/or guardian must sign the registration form on behalf of walkers under the age of 18 years.

Before You Walk

Bereaved Families of Ontario asks that walkers obtain pledges from sponsors of their choosing (ie: family, friends, teachers, neighbors, co-workers, companies etc)

Collect each pledge at the time that you recruit the sponsor. Cheques should be made payable to: Bereaved Families of Ontario – Southwest Region. Be sure to tell your sponsors that an official tax receipt will be issued for pledges of \$10.00 or more. Please **print** clearly on the pledge sheet.

The Walk to Remember is a Bereaved Families of Ontario province wide fundraising event sponsored by businesses in our community. Last year over 1,000 walkers took up the challenge and walked in memory of a loved one.

The London event will be held Sunday morning March 6th in Westmount Shopping Centre. All walkers register with their pledge sheets and may sign the “Wall of Memories” board adding a poem, photograph or other written message or memento, in their loved one’s memory.

The group gathers for a stretch and warm up exercise and then proceeds to walk a route through the hallways of Westmount (based on your pace it may be two, three or several laps).
